The main source of income of the inhabitants of the village is agriculture.</p> <p>We are located in a humble area of the town, so our students come from working-class families and we also accomodate Roma students together with certain immigrants from South America and East Europe.</p> <p>The school teaches the four levels of compulsory secondary education, among them we count with a 15 % of <u>special needs students</u>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Quite a few teachers live in the village, in which you will find a wide variety of leisure activities to choose from.
